Rules

- 1 All vehicles/machines must be insured, as necessary, to meet legal requirements.
- 2 All drivers must have the appropriate licence relevant to the class of vehicle/machine.
N.B. As this is a public event any breach will be an offence under the Road Traffic Act.
- 3 No unnecessary movement of attendant vehicles should occur within the event fields. Attendant vehicles to be parked as directed by SFA.
- 4 Only one person per tractor unless two seats fitted, no children on running vehicle/machinery permitted.
- 5 No vehicle/machine should be left running unattended.
- 6 Portable Generators – diesel generators only are permitted within event arena - as directed by SFA official.
- 7 No pets except on leash permitted within the event fields.
- 8 Fire breaks and emergency escape routes should be kept clear at all times.
- 9 All entrants shall comply with entry timing and specific requirements as advised/issued.
- 10 All exhibits shall remain on display until 4.00pm on the day of event.
- 11 Only one entry per form.
- 12 Fire extinguisher and First Aid Kit to be provided by entrant for working exhibits.
- 13 Each entrant will be allocated a designated area to work/display within. The entrant shall abide by the SFA Officials decisions/instructions at all times.
- 14 If you do not have your entry ticket you will not get access to the display field.
