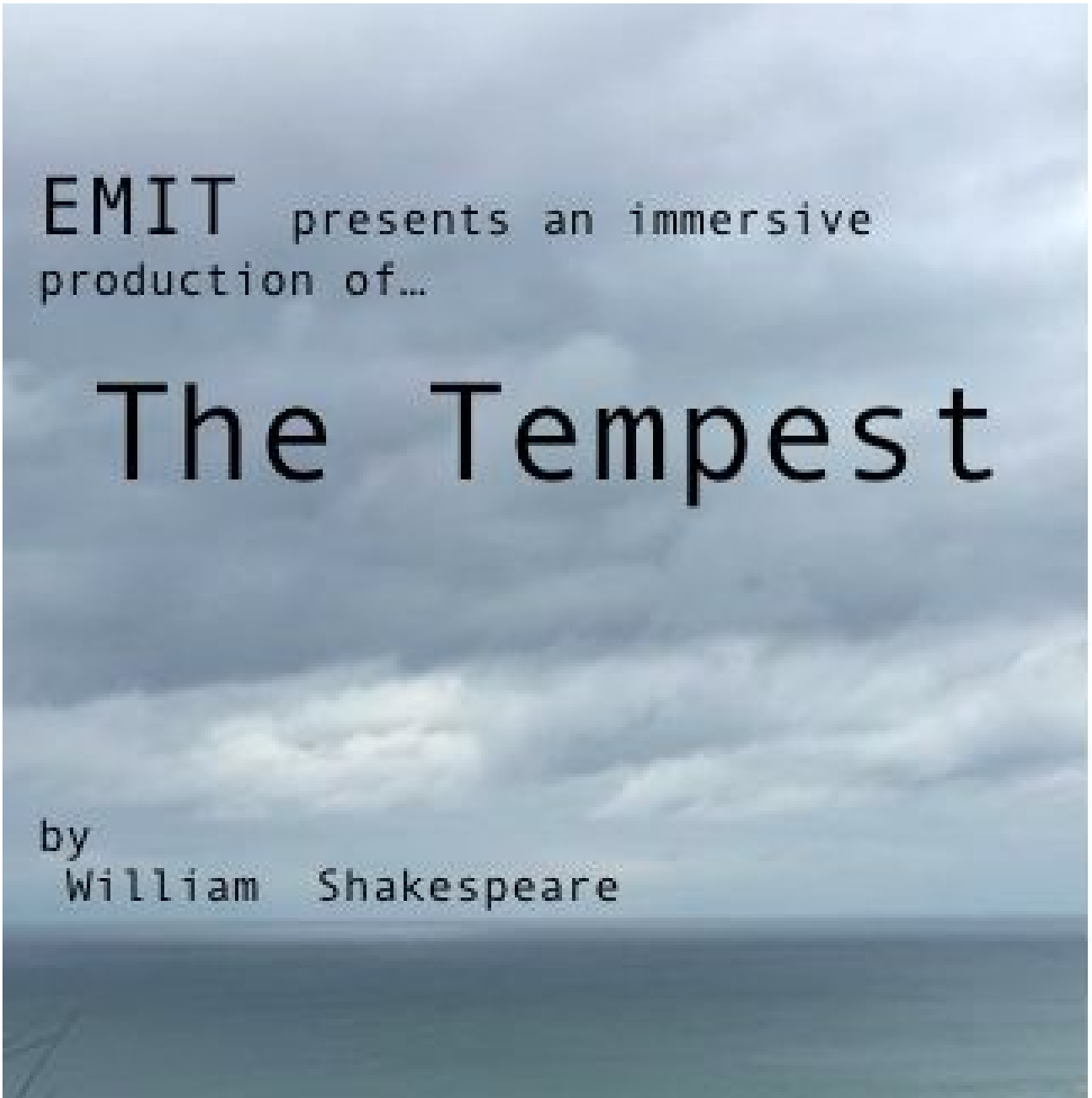

## Program Descriptions

### Immersive Theatre Workshops

This type of workshop seek to introduce and deeply engage students in the world of immersive theatre through hands-on activities. Students will explore the differences between a standard theatrical experience and an immersive experience. Workshops will incorporate storytelling, acting, and technical theatre elements.

### Play Prep Pre-Show Workshops

EMIT's Play Prep pre-show workshops uses arts integration to fully engage students with the content of the current production. Students will learn about plot, character, and tools for participating in an immersive theatre experience.

### Custom Theatre Workshops

### *The Tempest* - In School Performance

*The Tempest* is a Shakespearean comedy that at its core belies a story of forgiveness and family. Audiences will find themselves transported onto Prospero's wild, whimsical, enchanted island during the course of this immersive production. Participants will have the opportunity to experience unique, self-driven interactions in a choose-your-own-adventure format. This experience allows the audience to engage fully with the text and characters, as well some of the darker themes that drive the story, at their own pace and in their own way.

### *The Tempest* - Field Trip

Bring your students on a field trip to come see our immersive performance of *The Tempest* before we embark on our school tour. Pre and Post Show workshops are available in the space on the day of performance.

### What is Immersive Theatre?

In an immersive theatre production, audience members are given autonomy of movement and exploration during the performance. This enables the audience to have the perception of being physically present in fictional circumstances. Our form of immersive theatre allows the audience to make connections with the actors that reverberate throughout the rest of the play.

### Why choose Immersive Theatre for my community?

The founders of EMIT theatre are strong proponents of STEAM curriculum off and on the stage. EMIT is committed to an evidence based practice when it comes to our productions. Currently we are researching the impact of experiential learning and immersive theatre on Shakespeare comprehension in students. Our current research has shown that 97.8% of our students leaving an immersive experience describe themselves as having a clearer knowledge of the text.
