Get active...

Unleash your adventurous spirit as you feel the breeze in your hair using pedal power to cycle your way around the island or combine both bike and snorkel for an unforgettable land and sea experience.

Don't waste valuable time waiting in a queue, book a bike before you go! Ride straight from the jetty for breathtaking views, secluded bays and beaches.

Tips

- 1 There is no drinking water or food available outside the Thomson Bay and the Geordie Bay settlement areas, so don't forget your supplies - water, lunch, sun cream, bathers, towel and a camera are essentials!
- 2 During summer, bays on the south offer protection in the mornings from the prevailing easterly winds. By afternoon the famous Fremantle doctor comes in the south-west making the bays to the north such as The Basin, Parakeet Bay and Little Armstrong Bay the most enjoyable.
- 3 The island is 11km long by 4km wide and takes approximately 3.5 hours to ride around.

The Eco Express will complete a full circumnavigation (weather permitting) of Rottnest, offering passengers an unforgettable, entertaining and informative experience. The waters off Rottnest Island are teeming with wildlife, including the majestic Humpback Whales during September to November and closer to home watch the delightful antics of The New Zealand Fur Seal Colony out at Cathedral Rocks.

Historic Rottnest

Ferry and Train Tour

Join us aboard the Captain Hussey for a scenic train ride to picturesque Oliver Hill, as we take you on a guided tour of Rottnest's military history. Still preserved to this day, Rottnest's WWII-era guns and tunnels stand as a stoic reminder of a pivotal moment in time.

Situated just 18km west of the state capital of Perth, Rottnest Island was key in the line of defence of Western Australia during WWII. Most famously, Rottnest was home to a series of intricate, secret tunnels, and housed giant 9.2" guns as a defensive measure against any invading Axis forces.

These military artefacts are part of the rich and diverse timeline of Rottnest Island, which spans all of white settlement in Western Australia, and further back tens of thousands with indigenous culture.

The new 60 min Settlement Explorer tour will take you through the original settlement and includes picturesque vistas of the coastal areas through to Bathurst Lighthouse and the Basin swimming area.
