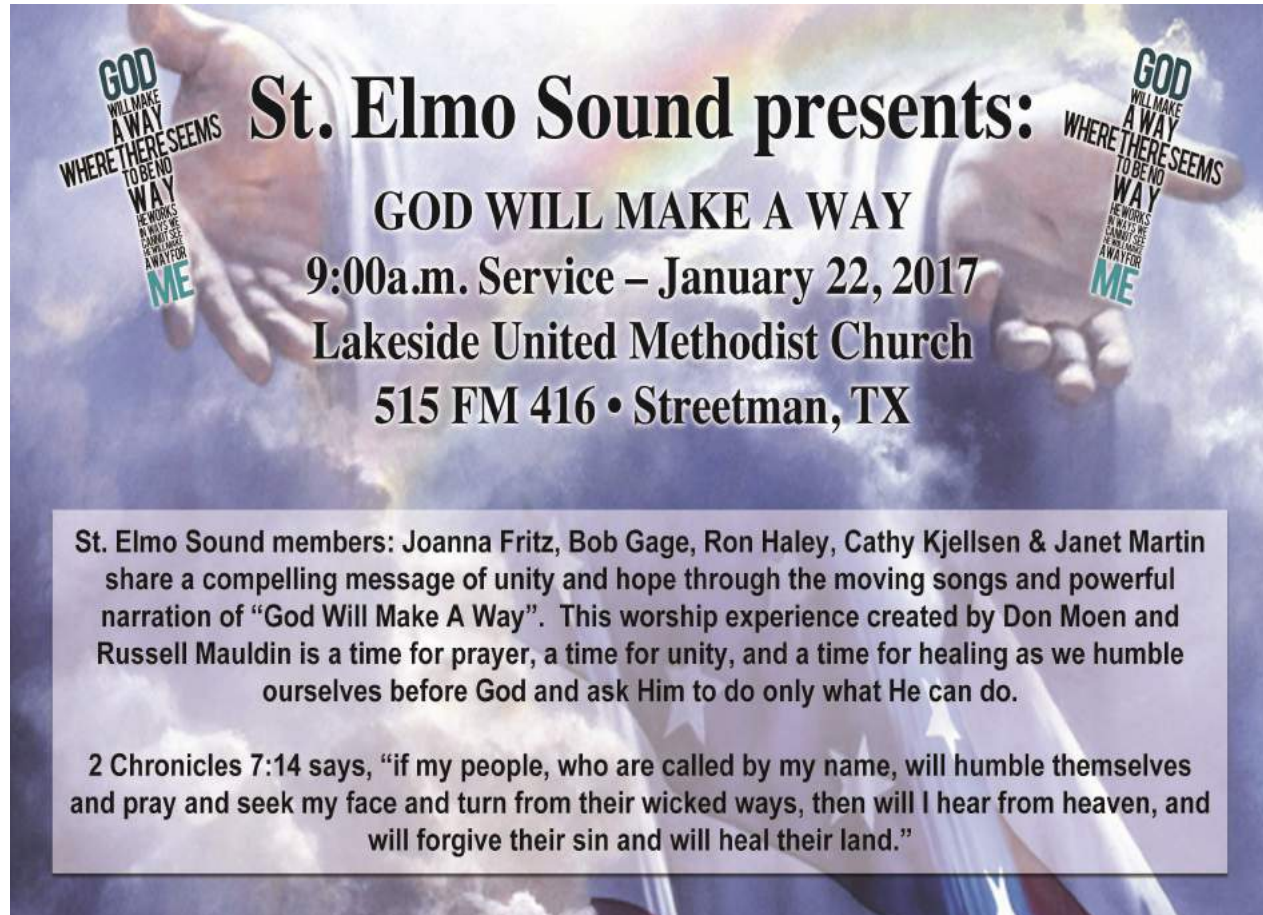
Judy Snowden continues to mend from a serious bronchial infection. She is very weak and doesn't get out much.
