**HURRICANE HARVEY UPDATES**

Our Central Texas Conference (CTC) is taking donations of many types to help those displaced and affected by Hurricane Harvey. Bishop Lowry requests that we all join together and help the people (first responders, rescuers, victims of flood and loss of property) as best we can. Monetary donations are recommended. The CTC will also accept cleaning buckets and personal hygiene kits. The information on putting together these kits is available in the September Newsletter (you receive either a hard copy or an email version), with the instructions also available on the counter in the kitchen. Any monetary donation provided should be clearly marked in the memo line of the check, or placed in a separate envelope (for cash) clearly marked **HURRICANE HARVEY**. All donations will be sent to CTC and we are reminded that **NONE** of the money will be used for any UMCOR overhead, all funds will be provided for disaster relief.
