Fall Garden Chores for East Texas:

- Prune crape myrtles of ONLY branches that rub together-do not top them!
- Now is the time for early crops of onions, spinach, strawberries and peas.
- Remove debris from roses to prevent black spot or other fungus.
- Spring bulbs can be planted now.
- If possible, leave the last mowing clippings on the lawn so they can decompose over the winter. Do not leave leaves on the grass.
- Clean out and compost plants from the garden as they stop producing.
- The best time to plant a new tree or shrub is after they have lost their leaves. It will give the root system time to develop over the winter that will stand up to the TX heat next summer.
- Clean out debris from around trunks of trees so you don't provide a winter home for rodents. Keep them well watered so it will be easier for them to go through a freeze.
- Deadheading of perennials and annuals can be done now if you want to save seeds for next year.

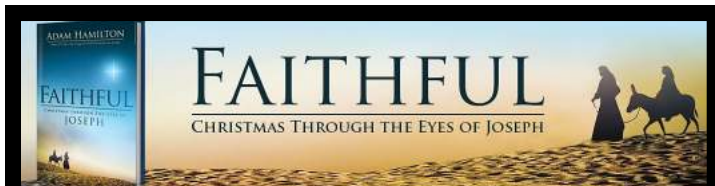
Mary Schutz reminded us that the funeral for **Joyce Pillans** is today at 3pm at New Hope Baptist Church.
