The Program Starts on June 7th!

A planning meeting was held last week and work is in progress on this new summer program! Each Thursday, at the Southern Oaks Community Center, our area children will have the opportunity to receive lunch, attend a book reading, read books, play and have fun. A decision was made to delete swimming from the program due to liability issues. Each child will leave with a bag filled with good snacks and activities to do at home.

A Meet-n-Greet will be held on June 3rd to introduce parents to the program. ***Note-this is not a religious program, but LUMC is strongly supporting this program with the Community Care Club, Fairfield Public Schools, the Fairfield Food Pantry, and the Southern Oaks Home Owners Association.***

What can you do?

- **Make Lunches:** Lunch menus are being drawn up at this time. We will be asking for donations to meet our menu requirements, and supplement this with the pledges of support we have received. We will be asking for two volunteers each week to shop and prepare our lunches. Look for notices in our Hear Ye and a sign up sheet on the bulletin board.
- **Read Books:** Volunteers to read books, play games and offer general supervision are needed. **-Only 2 hours a week!** Volunteers will be asked to become certified with MinistrySafe.
- **Donate Children's Books:** We will be reading books together each week, but everything will depend on the age group of those that show up! We'd like to be able to provide books to read during the session, and even some to take home and read. So go through your bookcase and donate kids books if you are able.
