Are you MinistrySafe Certified? We encourage everyone that works with our Children's Ministries to be a certified through the MinistrySafe program. MinistrySafe is a training program to help workers and establishments with children's programs to keep kids safe by recognizing and identifying child abuse of any form. The program is easy-all training is provided on the internet. It takes about 30 minutes or less to go through all the training modules. Yes-there is a test-but don't let that stop you! You will do just fine! There is paperwork, and every helper will undergo a background check. This check looks for any criminal activity-especially anything pertaining to child abuse. **With certified workers, the Church knows that you are safe and will be able to help keep our kids safe.** We can offer this safety point to the parents that bring their children here for our programs. **SIGN UP TODAY!** If you don't have a computer **NO WORRIES!** Use ours here at the church.
