Commission on a Way Forward: 5 Things you need to know

As a United Methodist, you may have heard about some of the things happening in our church today around the issues of human sexuality, and the work being done by a group called the Commission on a Way Forward. Their important work will help shape the future of the United Methodist Church. These five things offer an overview of the Commission on a Way Forward:

- <u>Formation</u>: At General Conference 2016 in Portland, there were an overwhelming number of proposals dealing with issues surrounding same-sex marriage, the ordination of LGBTQ clergy, and related topics. The bishops returned later in the General Conference with a plan. They would create a group to research and advise them of ways to help us move forward. The group they brought together is the Commission on a Way Forward.
- <u>Task</u>: The work of the Commission on a Way Forward is "to inform deliberation across the whole church and to help the Council of Bishops in their service to the next General Conference in finding a way forward". Their final report will be presented to a special session of General Conference, Feb 23-26, 2019 in St. Louis, MO.
- 3. <u>Issues:</u> The United Methodist General Board of Higher Education and Ministry (GBHEM) invited scholars to discuss the issues. Following the gathering, GBHEM produced "Unity of the Church and Human Sexuality", a study guide based on the scholars' conversation. The study guide can be found at: <u>https://www.gbhem.org/sites/default/files/study_guide_eng_final.pdf</u>.
- <u>Recommendations</u>: On July 31, 2018, the final report of the Commission on a Way Forward was released. - <u>Who decides?</u> The report will be received and acted upon by a special session of General Conference. This worldwide gathering of United Methodists will only act on items around our deep divide over homosexuality.
