Steve Schmidt's arm was broken when a tree fell on him.

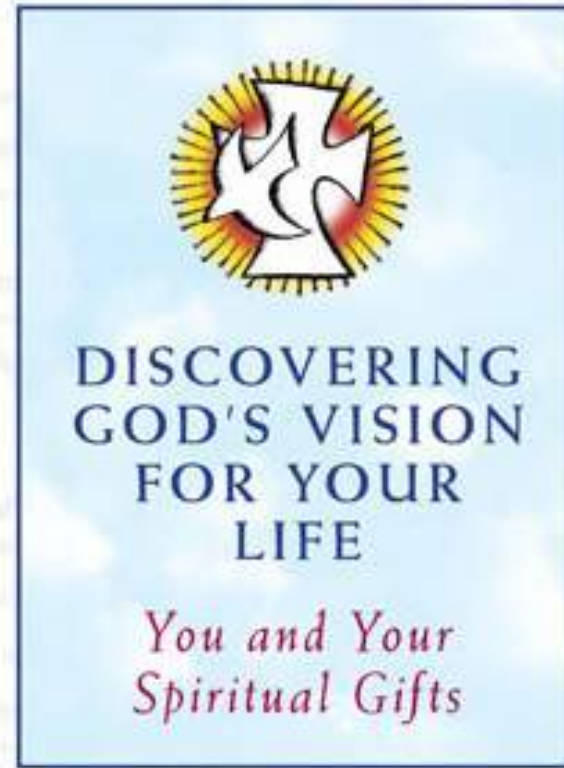
Please pray for **Tex Schutz's brother in law, Frank Lewis**. He was hospitalized after a fall.
