We pray for **the family of Jason**, who recently passed away. He is the friend of Merle Hughes' son, dying too young and leaving behind a wife and children.

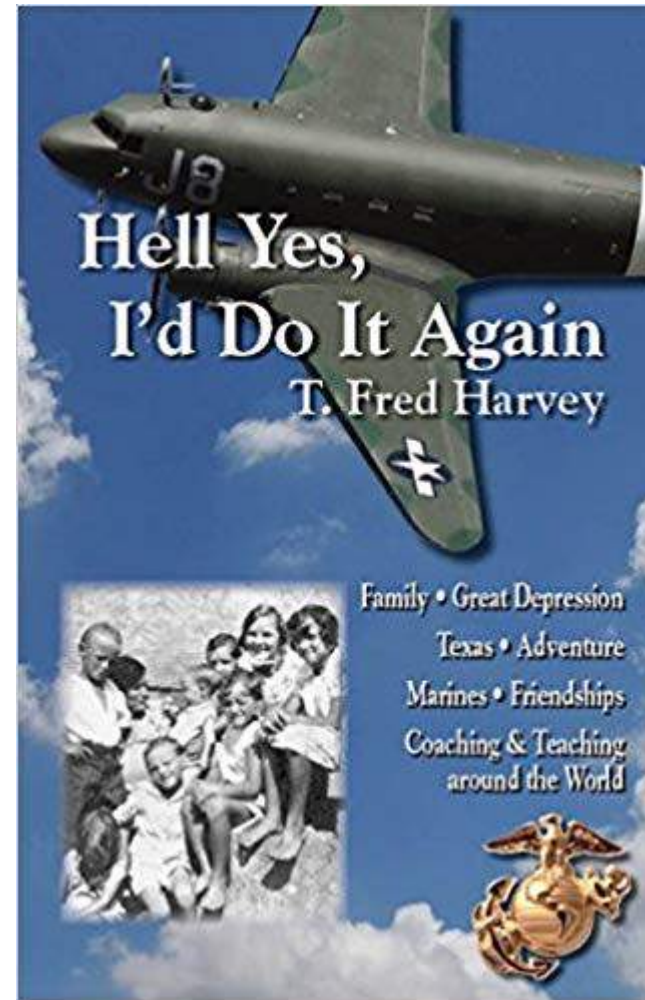
We pray for **Don Carlisle's family**. Don passed away after a short time in an assisted living facility and then placed on hospice.
