

EXPANSION PROJECT UPDATE

You may have noticed that the New Fellowship Hall is nearly completed! Van Wagnon reports that just a few finishing touches need to be made. Work has begun on the remodel of the Old Fellowship Hall. All construction is expected to be

completed by May 1st. Our budgeted costs for this room were \$207,509. The amount spent to build was \$207,416, which is **\$93 UNDER BUDGET**.

We have an amazing general contractor (Van Wagnon)! Work to remodel the Old Fellowship Hall was projected at \$25,450 with \$17,296 remaining to finish. In order to CELEBRATE this wonderful progress on our Expansion Project, we will provide a presentation of the work done and an overview of the Expansion Project and funding during a **FELLOWSHIP POTLUCK planned for March 3rd.** This CELEBRATION will also help us prepare for Lent.
