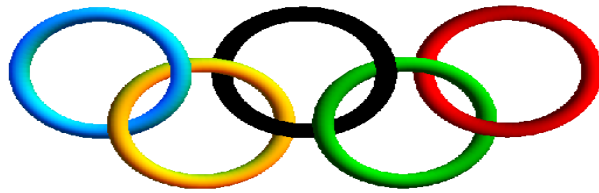


# Reading Olympics

<b>Bronze</b>	<b>30 books</b>	<b>20 books</b>
<b>Silver</b>	<b>50 books</b>	<b>35 books</b>
<b>Gold</b>	<b>70 books</b>	<b>50 books</b>

Monthly OLYMPIC CHALLENGES will be offered to help you stay on track. If you complete the challenge by the monthly deadline you will receive a small reward for participating. Completing ALL of the challenges will put you on track for a BRONZE Medal and with a little extra effort you can earn SILVER or GOLD!
