Packing List

Required Items:

- Refillable water bottle
- Work clothes (shirts with sleeves and long pants) enough for the entire week because laundry facilities will **not** be available
- Work shoes (hard-soled shoes at worksites, preferably steel toed boots and tennis shoes when working on roofs)
- Long sleeved shirt & baby powder (in case you will be working with fiberglass insulation)
- Leisure clothes (comfortable, discrete clothing)
 - Long shorts
 - Sleeved shirts
- Bible
- Personal toiletries (soap, deodorant, shampoo, toothbrush, toothpaste, etc.)
- Towels & washcloths
- Showering shoes
- Sleeping bag or bedroll including sheets and a blanket (While it is usually warm in Appalachia in June we do not control the HVAC and if there is A/C or other ventilation fans sleeping quarters are common space and it can cooler at night.)
- Pillow
- Air mattress or cot (twin size only)
- Rain gear or light jacket
- Hat and bandana
- Insect repellent
- Sunscreen / sun block
- Medications - both prescription and over the counter

Recommended:

- Personal tools and safety equipment including work gloves, eye protection, tape measure, pencils, nail apron, hammer all labeled with owner's name. A limited supply of "team tools" will be available If you do not have access to these item.
- Aloe Vera
- Musical instruments
- Devotional material
- Mini-flashlight
- Pen & paper/journal
- Inexpensive watch
- Anti-itch cream for bug bites (ex: Benadryl cream)

Items Not Appropriate for Mission (Please Do Not Pack)

- Cell phones
- Sweat pants can't be wore on work site – only back at center
- Short-shorts
- Shirts ripped out at the seams
- Half shirts (bare midriff shirts)
- Sleeveless, halter, spaghetti strap, or tank tops
- Muscle shirts
- Anything with bad language or inappropriate logos/slogans (alcohol or beer slogans, obscenities, etc.)
- Bikini bathing suits/Speedos
- Valuables, large amounts of cash, jewelry, tablets, computers
