GETS GLOBAL BERHAD CONTRIBUTES TOWARDS REALISING PUTRAJAYA GREEN CITY 2025 VISION

PUTRAJAYA, 12 October 2017 - GETS Global Berhad (GETS Global), (formerly known as KBES Berhad), announced today that the company through its wholly-owned subsidiary, Konsortium Bas Ekspres Semenanjung (M) Sdn Bhd, signed a memorandum of understanding (“MOU”) with Putrajaya Leisures & Services Group Sdn Bhd (PULSE Group) on the proposed equity participation in Pengangkutan Awam Putrajaya Travel & Tours Sdn Bhd (PAPTT).

The MOU was signed by Datuk Che Azizuddin bin Che Ismail, Managing Director of GETS Global and Dato’ Badlishah bin Hj. Ahmad, Group Chief Executive of PULSE Group. Upon completion of negotiations and signing of the definitive agreements, Konsortium Bas Ekspres Semenanjung will hold at least 79.99% equity of PAPTT.

Datuk Che Azizuddin Che Ismail, the Managing Director of GETS Global, expressed his optimism that this public and private sector partnership will deliver mutual benefits to all parties particularly towards realising Putrajaya Green City 2025 vision.

“With the support of our partner, FOTON, we will add electric buses in our fleet in a more significant way as part of our efforts to reduce the carbon emission, noise pollution, road congestion and improve public transport services in Putrajaya”, Datuk Che Azizuddin said.

Datuk Che Azizuddin added, *“Once completed, the proposed share participation in PAPTT will provide the Group with the much needed synergies to the existing business operations. Our entry into the stage bus services in Putrajaya is in line with the Company’s intention to broaden our earning base, create a sustainable income stream and explore new opportunities.”*

About PAPTT

Incorporated in 1995, PAPTT is a public transport service provider in Putrajaya managing city bus services, Putrajaya Sentral Terminal, Park & Ride facility, carparks and travel & tour services. PAPTT is supported by over 170 units of buses for Putrajaya internal routes and Klang Valley connectivity routes. PAPTT is jointly owned by Perbadanan Putrajaya and PULSE Group.

About PULSE Group

PULSE Group is a wholly owned subsidiary of Perbadanan Putrajaya with business portfolios in hospitality, MICE Center, hotel management, leisure & lake recreational, food & beverage services, event & park management, travel & tours and logistics services. PULSE Group is the major shareholder of PAPTT with 79.99% equity interest.

About GETS Global

GETS Global (Formerly known as KBES Berhad), is a Kamunting-based company which operates in three segments including Investment holding, express bus services, and fabrication of coach bodies and maintenance services. The Company's subsidiaries include Konsortium Bas Ekspres Semenanjung (M) Sdn. Bhd., which engaged in express bus services and investment holding; Super Coach Assembly Plant Sdn. Bhd., which is involved in the assembly and fabrication of bodies for buses and provision of related maintenance services; and Santero Sdn Bhd which is the exclusive importer and distributor of FOTON buses in Malaysia. GETS Global is listed in Bursa Malaysia by making its debut in 2002.

GETS Global has forged a partnership with Beiqi Foton Motor Co. Ltd on assembly and distribution of Foton buses in Malaysia and regional export. Beiqi Foton is a state owned enterprise and the largest commercial vehicle manufacturer in China and the world in terms of volume, having exported its products including electric buses to various countries. In August 2016, Santero Sdn Bhd has been appointed as the sole distributor of Foton buses by Beiqi Foton. In April 2017, Super Coach Assembly Plant Sdn Bhd has been appointed by Beiqi Foton to assemble Foton buses capitalizing its assembly facility in Kamunting, Perak.
