(1) 3rd Quarter Louisiana District Convention held at the Optimist Camp in Lafayette -Four members of our club recently attended the Convention. It was good to be able to gather with our fellow Optimist friends from all parts of the state while holding a very productive meeting for our District. All attendees were required to wear masks and social distance during the meeting for everyone's well-being.



(2) Summer Zoom Meetings - Our Westbank Optimist members have continued to stay in contact with each other during the pandemic by holding Zoom Board Meetings and Virtual General Meetings throughout the Spring and Summer months. Our President, Les Lowery, has been diligent in keeping our club tech savvy by assisting and encouraging everyone to complete the Zoom training offered by Optimist International. It is important to have members familiar with participating in Zoom meetings so that we can continue to work together to assist the children in our community. Our Club even held a fun event where all who attended the scheduled Zoom event were asked to join in a Virtual Scavenger Hunt. President Les Lowery and a group from our club volunteered their time to assist in handing out supplies to the evacuees on several occasions. Our club put together 150 Optimist Donation bags loaded with goodies and essentials for the children. The bags were distributed at the New Orleans Convention Center as part of the NOLA Ready effort.
