The Optimist Club recognizes that education is the key to a better way of life for our children, and no one with the Optimist Club of the Westbank understood that connection better than our long time member Sylvia Ricks. Mrs. Ricks worked tirelessly for the children of the Westbank. Her strong conviction for service and her belief in education, is the reason we named our scholarship in her honor. The Sylvia Ricks Scholarship Award is given to a Westbank student whose services to the community and academic achievements are best aligned with their future goals.

SCHOLARSHIP AWARD

All scholarships are a onetime scholarship. Scholarships will be given to candidates attending a traditional four year College/University program or a two year Technical College or Trade School.

CANDIDATE ELIGIBILITY AND QUALIFICATIONS

To be considered for a scholarship, student must satisfy the following minimum requirements.

- ➤ Candidate must have a cumulative high school Grade Point Average of 2.5 or greater based on a 4.0 scale.
- > Candidate must have a minimum of 18 ACT score.
- ➤ Candidate must have two letters of recommendation with original signature one from an educator and one from an outside source (not a relative).
- Candidate must have participated in extracurricular activities and provided community service activities OR must have work experience.
- ➤ Candidate must submit an essay of 400-600 words, typed, double spaced, single sided with references to research sources, if applicable.
- > Completed application must be submitted to the Optimist Club, postmarked on or before

Friday, February 28, 2025

*NOTE: If you live on the West Bank of Jefferson, Plaquemines, or Orleans (Algiers) parish, but attend high school elsewhere you can apply. The student must attend a Louisiana college or university. Exceptions will be considered if a Louisiana college or university does not offer the desired degree program.
