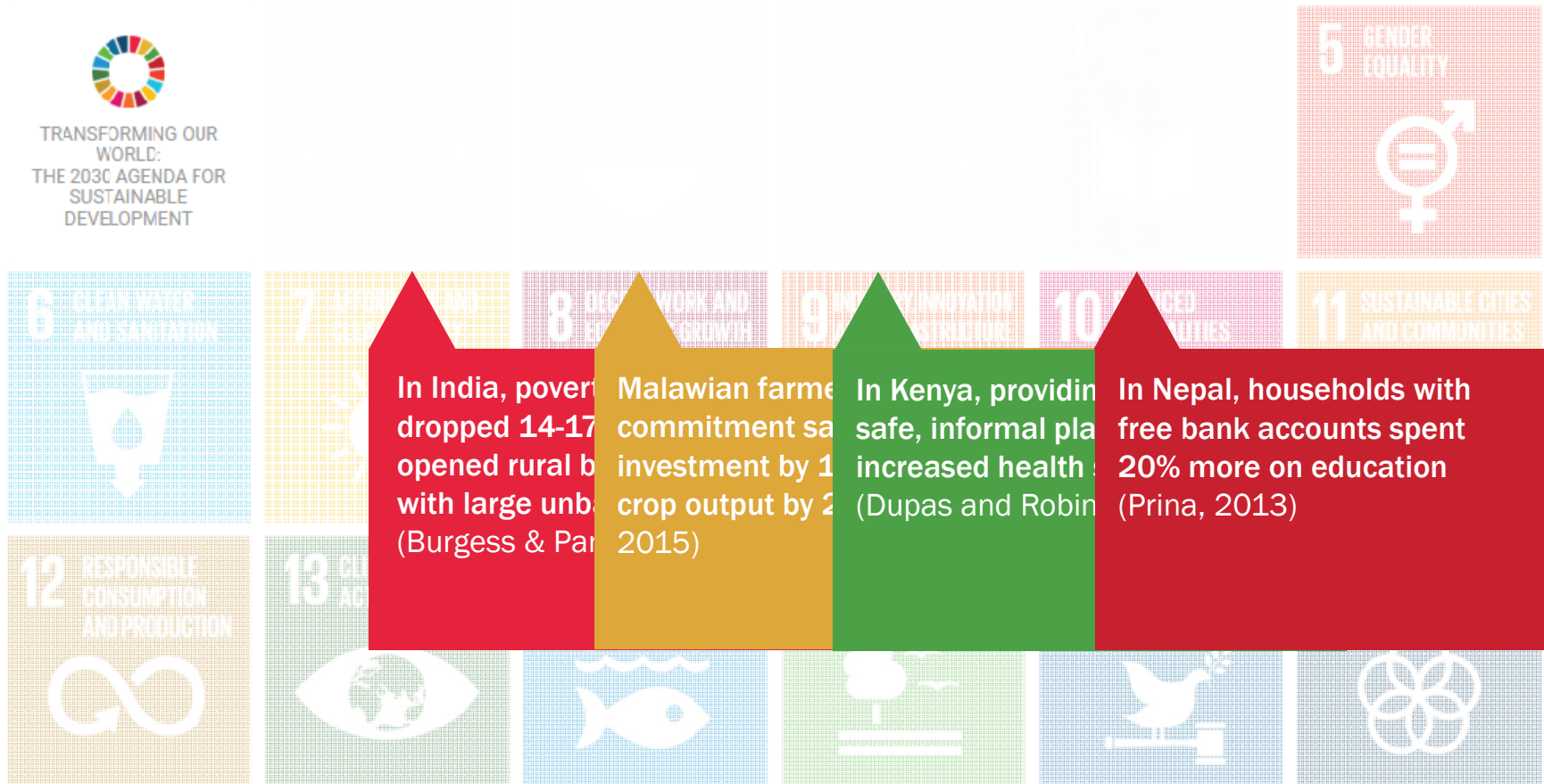

Short term credit for daily inventory purchase

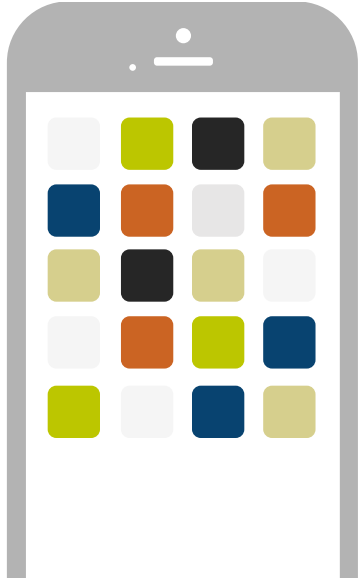

School savings scheme & top up credit

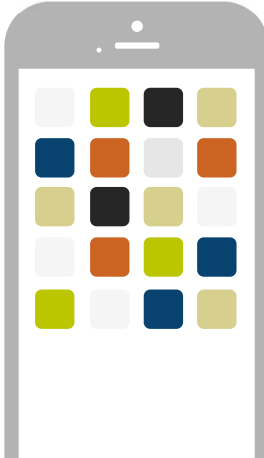
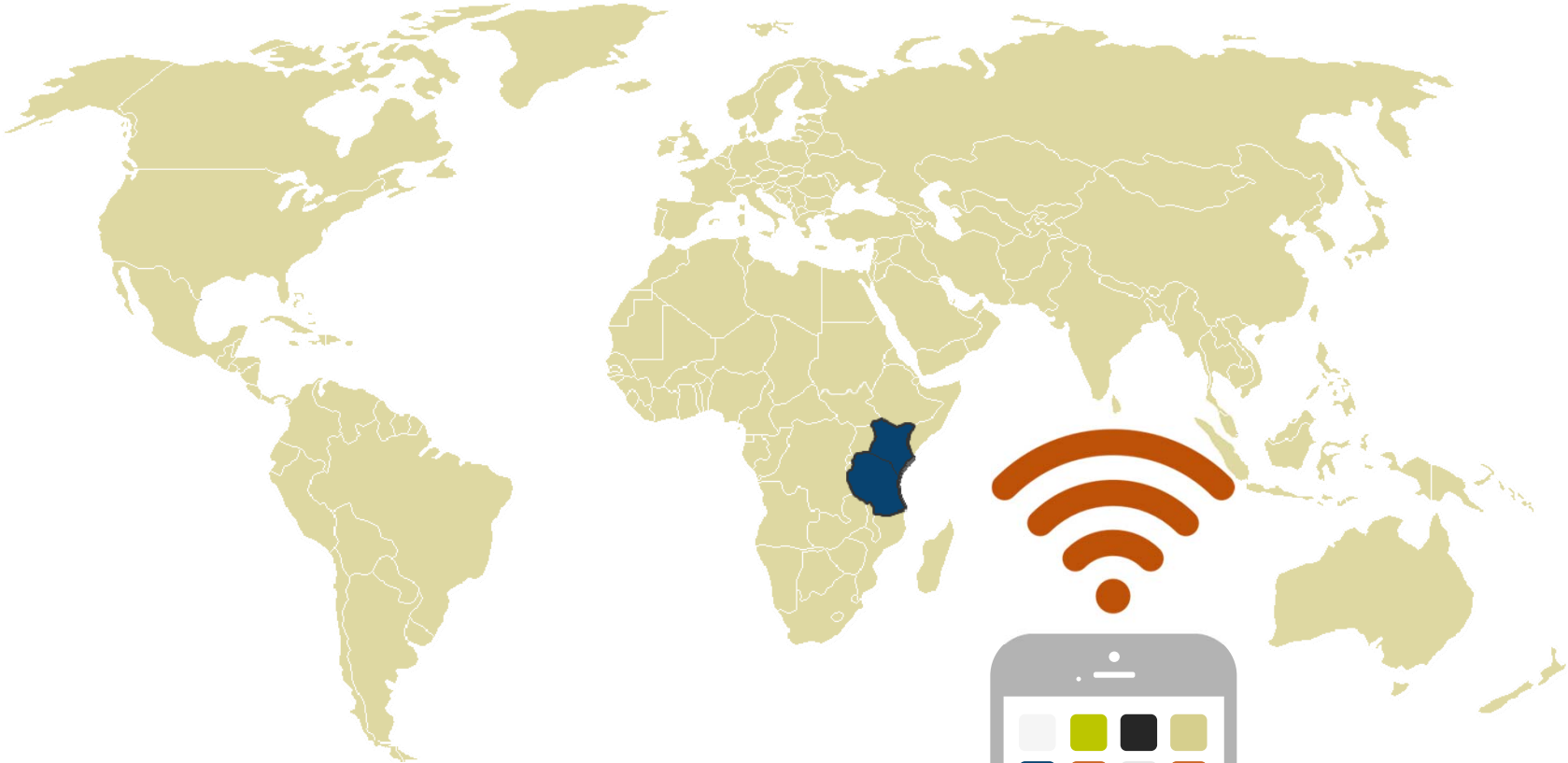
