What are Related Services?

Related services are only provided if it is determined that a student qualifies for special education under one of the categories listed above. Possible related services include:

- Audiology services
- Counseling services/Emotional Regulation
- School nurse services
- Speech-Language Pathology
- Occupational Therapy

Individualized Education Program (IEP) Meeting Guidelines

IEP Team Members: Parent(s), Student (if 14 years or older), Special Education Teacher, General Education Teacher(s), Representative of the District, possible Related Service Providers, and others as needed.

The typical agenda of an IEP meeting is as follows:

- A. Introductions (name, title, role/relationship to student)
- B. Purpose of the meeting (annual IEP meeting, evaluation report results meeting, significant change, etc.)
- C. IEP (review current student/family information, discuss strengths/needs of student or programming, update on progress of goals and objectives, discuss services, accommodations, LRE, ESY, para support if needed, state testing, etc.)
- D. Medical Assistance or MA billing (only if applicable)
