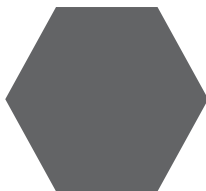
### Dr. Terry Mortenson

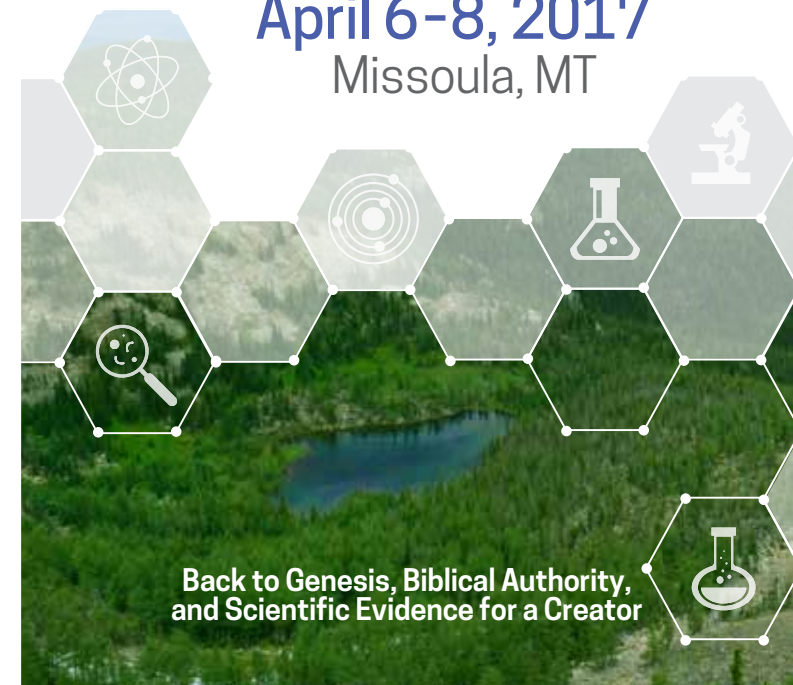
