

What You Need to Know About the Conference

Location: University of Montana, UNIVERSITY CENTER BALLROOM 3RD FLOOR, Missoula (University Center is located below the “M” on Mt Sentinel; you can see it from across the valley)

Conference is **FREE to the public**. If the ballroom reaches capacity, go down the hall next door to the UM Theatre to hear sessions, this is an overflow area to allow more participation.

- Sessions for elementary, high school & college students, families, and general public.
- Friday and Saturday Sessions doors open at 8:00 a.m.

- Hands-on kids programs Saturday morning and afternoon.
- Special presentations Sunday morning at area church services.
- **Come early to locate parking!**

PARKING INFORMATION – IMPORTANT

Designated Conference Parking Areas (labeled CONF in yellow on the conference map) Thursday & Friday DAYTIME (8:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m.)

Open Campus Parking all Thursday & Friday after 5:00 p.m. and all day Saturday.

For Thursday and Friday DAYTIME parking print & display CONFERENCE PARKING PASS and present to parking area attendants. This pass will allow you free parking with no confusion while parking in the two reserved lots is open (first come first serve).

- If designated parking areas fill up, there is parking along Campus Drive (see map) but after parking you will need to purchase a parking pass from volunteers along street or go into University Center 1st Floor at The Source (daily pass \$3) and place on dashboard.
- Fee parking also available in Hourly Parking Areas.
- We encourage you to arrive early to find parking and carpool or shuttle to the conference from your church, school, or park and ride location.
- If you have to park off campus you might look for space north of the Clark Fork River on side streets and walk across the river bridge and walk around the stadium to the University Center.

School Buses or Shuttles - Drop off/parking – Use the Prescott House pull-out near the bottom of the M. Need to park off campus at Dornblaser or Lewis and Clark until they return. Contact Shelley, UMPD, with questions at 406-243-6133.
