Trash Sack Program

This spring, the LNHOA board, under the direct supervision of Ric and Karen Abbott, ordered about 9,000 yellow trash sacks to be distributed around the lake. Currently, there are dispensers at five locations, keeping about 40 sacks free of charge, to help the lake users cleanup after their day at the lake. These bags are not only helping the city with cleanup around the lake and in the parks, but also adds good public relations with the city at large.

Trust Fund Items for Budget

When lake lots are sold or leased a portion of that money goes into a Trust fund, managed by the city. Currently this fund has about 14 million dollars in trust, and the monies are specifically to be used to maintain and improve the lake. The city is allowed to use the interest off this

fund for regular lake/park maintenance issues. However, some big ticket items need attention now. In order for the funds currently in trust to be made available, the residents of the city at large must vote and approve how such funds are to be used. We propose the following needs:

- Repair and make needed improvements to ALL boat ramps; re-open ALL closed ramps.
- Tear down and replace the public fishing pier near Sandy Beach. Move the nature center.
- Shoreline erosion improvements and remove vegetation/reed growth to original allowable.
- Repair existing public restrooms and install needed sewer/septic systems at Spring Creek and other park areas. Acquire large port- a-potties for busy holidays at Sandy Beach.
- Add a kids splash pad and miniature golf in park.
- Create a bird watching/wetland nature area near Beaty Road and Knickerbocker.

These accounts were billed again in July and again in August. If not paid, then the past due account will be added to the new billing cycle.
