

## How Fundraising Points are Calculated

Many of our fundraisers are events. To make it fair for everyone who puts time into these fundraisers, we have a “point system” to divide the fundraising dollars into team trip accounts. All fundraised money goes into the Mission Team account and cannot be used for any other purpose than the mission trip.

Here is how it works. We will let you know how many fundraising points you receive per hour worked, per desserts or other items needed, and per tickets or other items sold. Everyone’s points will be added up for the entire fundraiser. The total amount of money raised from that fundraiser will then be divided by the total amount of points, to give a value to each point. You will then receive that value for each point you received for that fundraiser.

Here is an example:

The Car Wash and bake sale brought in \$1,100. Here is how much each team member who worked the carwash made. (Note: these are not names from the team)

Name	Hours Worked = 1 point/hour	Desserts brought = 1 point/dozen
Bert	5	2
Ernie	4	1
Elmo	5	
Mickey	5	1
Donald	5	4
Goofy	4	2
Sleepy	2	2
Happy	8	2
Maisy	5	1
Minnie	6	3
Total Points	49	18

Total Funds = \$1,100  
Total Points = 67  
Value of each point = 16.42

Bert’s Account gets \$114.94  
Ernie’s Account gets \$82.10  
Elmo’s \$82.10  
Mickey’s \$98.52

You get the idea.
