

Royal Ball Ticket Information

- We have the potential of raising over \$6,000 through this fundraiser! Sell as many tickets as you can to friends, family, coworkers, neighbors, teachers, coaches, etc. Pre-sales start now! You will not get personal credit for tickets sold at shops, the Parish Offices, or through team sales, so make sure you are asking everyone you know! They can even choose your name when ordering online! To order online, go to triforcemissionteam.org/royalball.
- For **every 2 tickets you sell**, you will earn 1 fundraising point! (The more you sell, the more fundraising points!) **For every 10 tickets you sell**, you will get an entry into a drawing for a \$50 trip account bonus. The member who **sells the most tickets** will receive a Bluetooth speaker! (If more than one family member is on the team, your totals will be divided among number of your family on the team. For example, if you have 2 members of your family and you sold a total of 20 tickets, it would count for 10 each.)
- Tickets are **\$10 for an adult and \$10 for each child**. Tickets have a spot to fill out their name for door prize drawings. **They will turn this portion in at the door.** To help facilitate the entrance line, it would help if this portion was filled out before the event, but we will have pens available at the door if needed. The adults will also be entered in to a drawing. **All tickets must be presented at the door to enter.**
- If you need more tickets, please let Carrie or Andrea know asap. We are only selling 300-350 tickets per event in order to stay within fire code. Tickets will most likely be sold out before the event, so please do not wait to sell tickets. Once tickets are sold out, we will have to turn people away. Please let friends and family know that if tickets are available at the door, the cost will be \$12 ea.
- There will be two events again this year. Both will be held on **March 3rd in the SLS Activity Center. The EARLY BALL will be from 12:30-2:30 (doors open at 12:15)** and the **LATE BALL will be from 3:30-5:30 (doors open at 3:15)**. Again this year, there will be a **Pirate Cove set up at the Ball**, as well as **activities that would be fun for girls and boys**. We hope that more boys will be able to join in the fun!

Royal Ball FAQ

Q. Can a parent drop their kids off and pick them up when it's over.

A. No. We are not set up to watch them. We would be liable for the kids and in a crowd of 400 people, that would be almost impossible. The children should be accompanied by an adult or a trusted babysitter.

Q. Do adults need a ticket to bring their child?

A. Yes they do! Since we are limited on the amount of people we can fit into the activity center, we will need to require tickets for adults as well. When getting tickets for friends and family, please let us know how many are adults and how many are children so we have enough supplies for the activities, but the youth and adult tickets are the same. Please specify which Ball (Early 12:30-2:30 or Late 3:30-5:30). There is a place on the ticket to circle whether it is for a youth or adult for the drawing.

Q. Is the Royal Ball appropriate for all ages?

A. Yes! The target audience is about 2-10, but all ages may enjoy the Ball

Q. Is the Activity Center handicap accessible?

A. Yes! And we will have a couple of greeters at the door to help operate the elevator to get our guests to the lower level safely. There are also handicap stalls in the restrooms.

Q. How long are tickets available?

A. Until they are sold out. It is possible that there will be tickets available at the door, but there are no guarantees and the price will go up to \$12. We will keep everyone posted on the availability of tickets when we start to get close.

Q. How old does a child have to be to need a ticket?

A. One year and older will need a ticket to enter. Children under 1 are permitted with a paying adult.

Q. Can boys come too?

A. Absolutely! Thanks to the addition of the Pirate Cove! The Pirate Cove will be set up with pirates, fairies, and other fun characters. There will be activities that boys will enjoy as well.

Q. Will we be serving food for our guests?

A. Yes. There will be kid-friendly snacks and drinks. However, a full meal is not provided. (There will be meals and snacks provided to the workers and characters before, between, and after the events!)

Q. If someone buys tickets and cannot make it last minute, can they get their money back?

A. Hopefully they will consider the \$10 a donation to the team. However, if they feel they need to be reimbursed, we can do so. It would be helpful to know as early as possible so we have time to resell their ticket.
