She is the Executive Director of the Center for Environmental Ethics and Law (www.environmentalethicsandlaw.org), a US-based non-profit organization that advances environmental ethics in law and policy. She has been leading the Biosphere Ethics Initiative (BEI) since its inception in 2005, adopted by the IUCN General Assembly in 2012 as a guiding policy for IUCN. The BEI is a soft law program that works with local and regional communities around the world to highlight ethics in action, and translate that action into local, national, and international law and policy. Her areas of expertise and scholarship are at the intersections of social justice, the environment, comparative law, ethics, and corruption.
