To all current and potential travellers on the DASC run coaches.

The Supporters' Club committee has decided to overhaul the Supporters Coach Travel and update it to take account of current situations.

DASC are very proactive in trying to run coaches to every away trip and offer Dover Supporters' a competitive price in a friendly relaxed Coach.

Commencing with the North Ferriby coach (18/02/17), travellers will continue to book in the normal way with Andy Fisher via a Call or Text to him on 07934 300335, or by email to dasccoaches@gmail.com, or by seeing him in the Centre Spot before or after every Home game.

However, you will now be required to **pay for your seat in advance** in cash or by cheque either at Home games or via Bank Transfer if preferred; the bank details are shown below. Simply advise Andy when booking your coach seat/s that you have paid by Bank Transfer.

The Treasurer will confirm to Andy that payment has been received.

This will help in a number of ways including security for the coach operative who will no longer have to carry large amounts of cash upon their person as there are no secure facilities provided on the coach.

The new way of payment has been well received by many of our regular travellers and we hope you appreciate that a change was needed.

All we ask is that you book early as normal as we need to book and arrange coaches as soon as possible.

RULES FOR THE COACH TRAVEL

All vehicles are NON SMOKING.

No alcohol will be permitted on our vehicles at any time. This means not just drinking alcohol but also taking it on the coach.

Any damage caused will be charged to the Supporters Club and any abnormal or excessive cleaning will result in a £50 fine payable by the Supporters Club.

If any coach traveller identifies a problem when boarding the coach, they should inform the person overseeing the coach.

No excessively rowdy behaviour will be tolerated on board the coach.

The coach company runs a ZERO TOLERANCE POLICY so, if any of the above restrictions are breached and any individual found to be flaunting the rules they will be removed from the coach immediately, irrespective of the location of the coach.

It is obviously in everyone's interest and to encourage people who are understandably wary about using the coach that behaviour is kept within the bounds of common sense.

Pre-arranged drop-offs and pick-ups will be permitted en route only with no detours.
