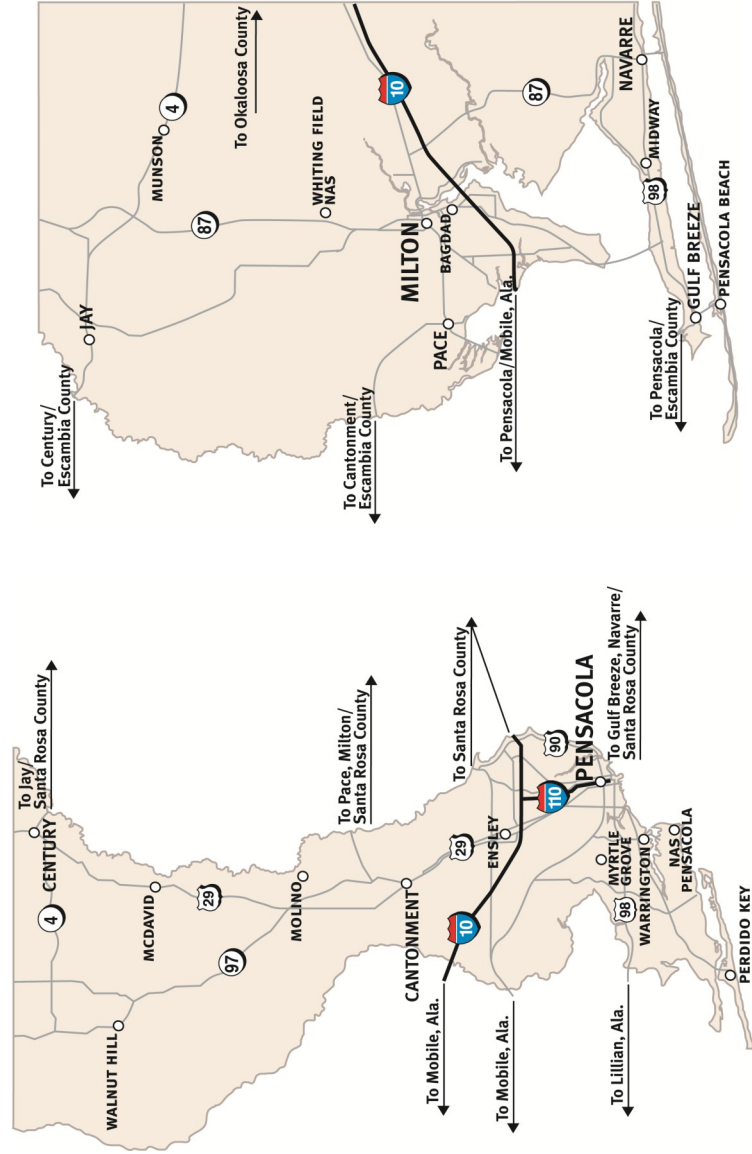

**HOW TO REQUEST FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE
FROM THIS AGENCY LIST**

1. Check first to see if they serve your county.
2. Check times to call—most are early morning.
3. **CALL agencies, NO walk-in service available.**
4. Continue to redial until you either speak to a staff member or you reach the agency’s answering machine.

Things to Remember

1. Agencies will screen calls to verify eligibility
2. Most agencies serve only once per year or per life-time
3. United Way 2-1-1 has up-to-date information on documentation required, eligibility, hours of operation, etc.

The Marchman Act is initiated through the court with a petition followed by a hearing.
