DAYS & Teams may be designated as "Recurring" and thus, are NOT required to call in before each penning.

QUICK DRAW, GREEN NOVICE, GREEN HORSE/COLT & YOUTH RIDERS: Please call in or email if you know you are

attending the event **BUT** final sign up on Office table on day of Class.

PLEASE CHECK, CHANGE or ADD TEAMS AT THE PENNING ASAP. 10:30 a.m. cut-off for Open & Quick-Draw.

REVISIONS to teams can be made on the day of the Penning via "Team Change" forms.

BUCKLE AWARDS TO FIRST PLACE WINNERS: PAN & YOUTH Divisions.

(*1) **OPEN**: Enter up to **4** times, change 1 rider per team.

(*2) LMTD OPEN & AM: Make the 50% back for the Open or Amateur class with cattle penned.

(*3) QUICK-DRAW: Enter 1 time AT Event for 3 Draw teams. Minimum of 9 riders is needed for this Class to run.

Riders must be rated a 4, 5 or 6 AND must ride in the Open Class at least once.

(*4) AMATEUR: Enter up to 4 times. Mandatory 1 Pick Team & 1 Draw Team

(*5) NOVICE: Enter up to 3 times. Mandatory 1 Draw Team. Rider may draw all three teams if they choose.

(*6) GREEN NOV. DRAWPOT: Enter up to 3 times AT Event for Draw Teams (but calling in would be appreciated). One Open or AM

rider will ride with Green Novice teams.

Low-fee, no-payout learning class, but a Year-End Award will be given to the overall Hi-Point winner.

(*7) GREEN HORSE/COLT: Horse may not have competed in 2 separate penning events; Horse Rating form must be completed,

submitted and approved by Rating Committee; seasoned horse may "fill in" if no green horse is available. 2 Team limit per horse. Will run concurrently but separate from Green Novice Drawpot. Calling in would

be appreciated.

(*8) YOUTH DRAWPOT: Enter AT Event for 2 Draw teams (but calling in would be appreciated). Riders rated 2 or less & must be

16 years of age or under as of 01/01/19. HELMETS REQUIRED for youth under 13. One Open or AM rider

will ride with the Youth, but no parents of <u>any</u> of the youth rider(s). No fee to the adult rider. No adults

on young, in-training horses.

(*9) PAN (Pro-Am-Nov): Enter up to 4 times, change 1 rider. Not necessary to ride in a Division to be eligible to ride in the PAN.

(1 Open + 1 AM + 1 Nov) or (1 Open + 2 Nov) or (1 AM + 2 Nov) or (2 AM + 1 Nov) or (3 Nov) riders.

DIRECTIONS:

FROM YAKIMA: take Highway 97 to the first stop light. Turn right onto Lateral A and go to the first stop sign. Turn right onto West Wapato Road (at Wheeler's Kountry Korner) and continue to the end where it meets Stephenson Road. Turn left and go 3.5 miles until the stop sign. Cross intersection and the railroad tracks and watch for signs to Winters Arena on the left.

COMING FROM THE SOUTH I-82: Take Exit 50, Buena, turn left onto Buena Rd (Way). Turn right onto Branch Road. Turn left onto Stephenson Road. Cross the railroad tracks and watch for signs to Winters Arena on the left.

QUICK-DRAW CLASS: The Board wants to remind everyone that it is for riders rated a 4, 5 or 6. Interested riders should verify their Rating on the Club's website before entering.

SETTLING THE HERDS: It has been requested that riders stay out of the arena while the cattle are being settled to avoid disruption to the herds. Please use the warm-up areas during this time.

ARENA WARM-UP: Riders should stay off the cattle end of the arena to avoid compaction of this area.

SPOTTING CATTLE: No spotting of cattle will be allowed from the sidelines. A 15-second penalty can be accrued by the team penning at the judge's discretion. (Spotting is locating cattle in the herd and calling out location to the riders in the arena.)

RIDING "UP" IN A DIVISION: Riders will earn points in Divisions that they ride up in! A Top-10 award and jacket will be awarded to those riders placing in the top ten. No award will be given for placing out of the top ten.

OVERNIGHT STAY: No tie-up fee. Limited Pens @ \$10/each. Call Patty Winters @ (509) 949-1014 to reserve.

RIDING APPAREL: Shirt with sleeves (long or short), pants, and western boots with a heel. \$20 fine for each non-conforming ride.

CONSESSIONS: None expected at the time of printing

PETS: Please try to keep pets out of the arena.
