## **History of St John Fisher of Rochester – 14**

John Fisher's work for his university had prospered; Christ's College was established, and in spite of all the obstacles, St John's had been well founded. His encouragement of sound learning and preaching, and of the study of Greek and Hebrew had helped to lead Cambridge out of the lethargy of the past into the more vigorous world of the new scholarship.

**Youth Group in Our Parish:** Our young people gather in our parish Hall once a month on a Sunday evening 5 o'clock. The parents are also present at the same time in the Hall. On 19<sup>th</sup> February, we are going to have a training programme on ***SEE, JUDGE AND ACT***. **Second Collection Next week for the new pavement and the fibreglass roof:** we have a safe pavement in front of our church with a permanent ramp. The Presbytery flat roof had cracks and leaks. Now it is repaired with a fibreglass roof and has got 25 years guarantee. The total expense for the pavement and the fibreglass is £ 6,728.79 [£3494.79 + £3234 each]. We are grateful for the Christmas Fair collection [£559.32] for this purpose. The next week second collection will be a help to carry out other church roof repairs. The second collection envelopes are kept at the porch.
