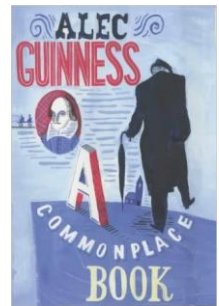
The Prodigal Son Bible Study (Session 3 this morning 9:45am)

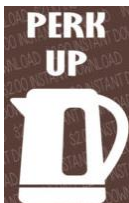
