Eligibility

All artists who submit an application with the non-refundable fee of \$20 by June 15th or \$25 after June 15th will be included in the jury process.

Media include painting, photography, ceramics, fiber art, leather, jewelry, glass, leather, metal paper, mixed media, wearable art, wood and sculpture. All art must be made by the artist. If accepted into the show artists must agree to donate a piece of their art for a silent auction and agree to donate 20% of their gross sales up to a maximum of \$300 to TBK/WRJ. For this donation you will get a tax-donation letter.

Booth Information

The booths will be 10 x 10 ft. We do not offer double booths. A 6 or 8 ft. table and 2 chairs will be provided for each booth.

If electrical is required there will be an additional fee of \$12 payable with the registration fee.

Artists from Out of Town

Special arrangements can be made upon request for artists coming from further than 50 miles for the show to set up between 7-9am on the day of the show.

Food & Beverages

Free coffee and bottled water is free to artists all day. Lunch can be ordered prior to the show and paid for at the show.

Entry Instructions

- Each applicant must submit the application form with a description of their work.
- Each applicant must submit the registration fee (\$20 before June 15th - \$25 after June 15th) and the additional \$12 if an electrical outlet is needed with the application.
- Checks should be made payable to: TBK/WRJ Sisterhood.

- Your art will be advertised on our website unless you specify otherwise in your application.

Sales at the Show

All sales including 8% sales tax will be handled by a Central Cashier. Cash and credit cards will be accepted – no checks. Credit card fees will be absorbed by TBK/WRJ. Checks will be mailed to artists with their 80% + 8% tax within 3 business days & artists will be expected to remit sales tax to NYS.

Set Up at the Show

- Parking is at the rear of the building. Vendors may pull up at the south or west porticos and unload and then immediately park in the back parking lot. Volunteers will direct you.
- Booths will be marked with blue tape.
- Volunteers will be available to direct you to your booth, answer questions and give you restroom breaks & shopping breaks.
