- I shall assume responsibility for my special event at the pavilion at Notasulga Municipal Park.
- I shall pay the Town Hall **\$75.00 (per 2hr event, if over 2hrs each additional hour will be \$15.00)**. In the event of rain on the rental date, a reschedule can be granted. **Refunds are not given for inclement weather.**
- I hereby release the Town of Notasulga, the Town of Notasulga officials, the Town of Notasulga employees and any Town of Notasulga volunteers from all responsibility and liability in occupancy, maintenance and condition of the premises.
- I shall indemnify protect and save harmless the Town of Notasulga from any loss, cost, damage or expenses caused by injuries to persons or property while in or on said premises herein reserved.
- Playground remains open to the public.
- I must provide my own 55 gallon trash bag.
- I shall clean the pavilion area (including restrooms) upon my departure. I shall provide for garbage collection and not leave garbage at the pavilion. All garbage must be put in trash bags and placed in the dumpster.

- No admittance after dark without approval from Town Hall.

The use of the pavilion requires prior approval that can be obtained at Town Hall.

The park may be used 7 days a week from dawn to dusk. Entrance may be gained through the small gate marked entrance; if the large gates need to be opened please contact Town Hall two days prior the event.

Violation of the above rules, other misconduct, or vandalism may result in removal from the park and/or criminal charges.
