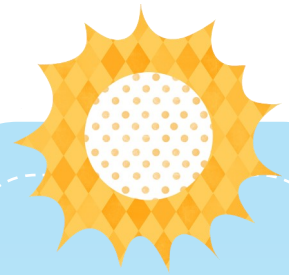

Europe Trip

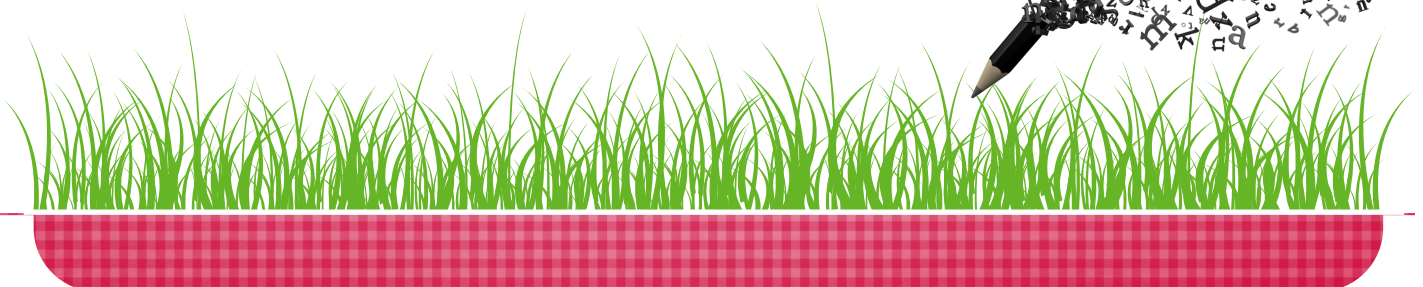
Red is for love
