QUALIFICATION CRITERIA (per guidelines established 1996)

Each year the committee will decide on the number of awards to be given, depending on the number of nominations received. The categories and their qualifications are to be as such:

Distinguished Graduate; Must have graduated at least 20 years previously. Nominees will be considered for their outstanding success in his/her chosen profession and service to their community.

Faculty or Staff: A teacher or staff member who is currently on staff will not be considered for any category until they leave NWHS or retire.

Outstanding NWHS Supporter: This can be an individual or business that has supported the school in time or money in the past.

Examples: Adopt-a-School partner, Past PTA Presidents, parents, alumni
