



What is a Lash Lift?

Not like the old way of doing it with perm rods. The lash lift is done with smooth silicone gel pads, kind of like the old technology but better. The silicone pads used for this procedure lifts the lash from the root in an upward fashion that produces length and a bright eyed enhanced look.

How long does the Lash Lift last?

A Lash Lift will last for about 2-3 months depending on your specific lash growth cycles, can vary from person to person. There is no need for any maintenance appointments in between, but you will need to have the process repeated every 2-3 months to lift the new hair growth.

How long does the procedure take?

The procedure typically takes around 1 hour and 15 minutes, depending on if you have them tinted at the same time.

Does the Lash Lift procedure hurt?

No. The procedure is totally painless. You will have your eyes closed for the entire treatment and although it may feel a little strange being unable to open your eyes for this time, it offers you a chance to relax during the treatment.

Is the procedure safe?

Yes. Lashes are lifted onto our specially shaped silicone lifting pads before products are applied.

Will I have a reaction to the lotion?

Very few people have a reaction to the lotion, but that doesn't mean you won't be one of them. What one person reacts to, another is fine with. This is why you can opt to have a patch test 24 hours beforehand. A patch test is quick and simple. It consists of me placing 2 drops of lotions behind the ear for 15 minutes. Wiping it off and waiting to see if any subsequent irritation occurs over the next 24 hours such as redness, itching or inflammation for example.

I wear contact lenses, can I have this procedure?

Yes. However, I will ask you to remove them temporarily during the treatment, as the eyes will be closed throughout.

How do I clean my eyes?

You can clean your eyes using mild oil-free products. Always wait 24 hours to do this, straight after the procedure.

How often can I have a lash lift?

A lash lift will begin to naturally drop after about 2 to 3 months and your lashes will be back to their natural look. The lashes should drop evenly and will not look out of place. You can repeat the treatment after a minimum of 1 month if you feel you need to, or you can wait until they are back to their natural state.

How do I care for my lashes after the Lash Lift?

- First 24 hours afterwards:
 - do not get your lashes wet
 - do not use mascara
- Do not use and eyelash curler, doing so may weaken and damage your eyelashes
- Do not use waterproof mascara or oil based products; including eye makeup removers and creams
- Swimming, using harsh products or heat can lead the lash lift to drop/weaken prematurely. If you find that your lift does not last the full 2 months, you can repeat the treatment after a minimum of 4 weeks of having the initial treatment, but not before
