

Let's also pray for all of our faculty as they continue to do such a good work for the Lord in Aboaso, Ghana.

With this in mind, there are many pressing things that need to be taken care of with the school in Ghana. Especially the situation with our facility, which we only have leased through the end of the year. Due to these needs, Brent and I will be traveling to Ghana in early February to sort out some of these things and to plan for the future. We will leave February 3<sup>rd</sup> and return around the 19<sup>th</sup>. Please keep us in your prayers as we make plans for this trip and that we might be able accomplish everything necessary to the glory of God and for the furtherment of His Kingdom.

Well, I look forward to our mid-week gathering this evening. I hope you are planning to be present. May God bless us all as we continue to serve Him and do all things according to His perfect Will.
