

Since last week's report, we have begun teaching classes at the school. I am teaching General Biblical Introduction, N.T. Greek, and The Preacher and His Work. Brent is teaching Hebrew History and the Minor Prophets. This group of students is a really fine one, and they all seem eager to learn and to grow in their knowledge of God's Word. They seem to be very busy in their studies, but also very happy to have the opportunity to grow in teachings of the Bible.

In the Preacher and His Work class, I have assigned them Bible topics and we are getting to hear each student preach a sermon. It is a lot of fun and good to hear them and to see how they are improving in their skills. We also critique them, so that they can have some good feedback for areas of improvement. It is exciting to see them learning and using their skills.

We also had a great Sunday worshiping with our brethren in Daaho/Borofour. One of our graduates from Zambia preaches there and is doing a great job. We had 98 present and the congregation is only 6 months old. It was a wonderful day of worship.

Starting today (Tuesday) we will begin to visit congregations in the evening, after we teach. While in Ghana we not only teach at the school, but we also visit and encourage local congregations, many of which our graduates are at. There are many churches which need encouragement in this area. Unfortunately, we won't be able to visit them all, but will be able visit many and encourage them in their Christian walk.

On Saturday, we will have a seminar with our graduates. We will also include our current students. This will be a great day of study and growth, and as well we will get to see those who have completed the course before and who are out doing the work of the Lord. Praise be to God for His good work in Ghana.

Please keep us in your prayers as we continue our Labors here in Ghana. We look forward to seeing you all again in about a week and a half. We love you and God bless!
