



While there Edith added over a hundred books to the Library. I was able to present lessons at the school and help them plan the completion of the project. One baptism took place while at the church that is in front of the school. I'll I share with you some pictures of our trip soon.

Edith and I did have some complications from the trip. I was bitten in three places while on the trip and we still don't know what caused the bites. Edith, on the other hand, also received a wound that Mercy failed to recognize. Although we did go to the Mercy ER, we were just given antibiotics and told to go to our regular doctor in two days. We are scheduling that visit ASAP. Other than that, we both made the trip in good fashion. A special thank you who helped support the trip with financial help and with prayers and encouragement.

The great thing about the work is that 18 men are still there studying the Word of God and preparing to preach the gospel in Uganda and in Kenya. I wish you could have been there to hear their stories concerning what they want to do in their lives.
