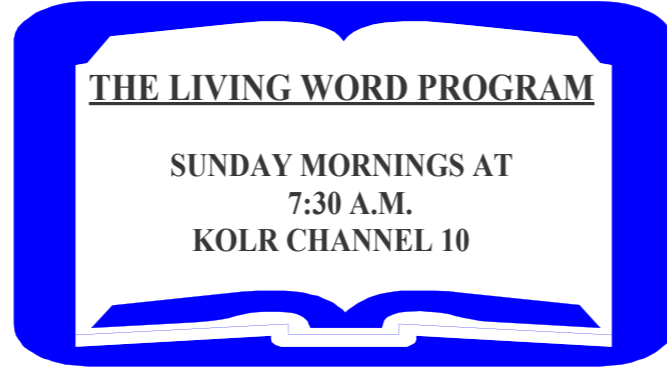

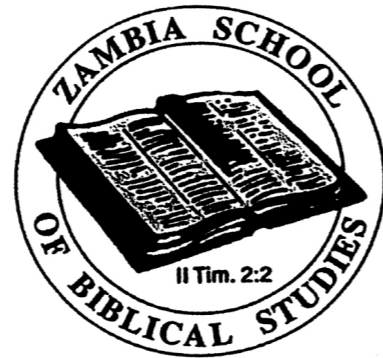

RAY'S REMARKS:



Lord willing, Brent and I are now in Ghana and striving to do the Lord's work with the brethren there. We are primarily working with the brethren in the Ashanti region and the specific city we will be in is called Kumasi. We have over 22 congregations to visit while in Ghana, to encourage the brethren and to challenge them to keep up the good work. We will also be preaching in a Gospel meeting and trying to help in establishing at least one new congregation in the area.

While in Ghana we will also teach one Saturday at the school. The school is called the Ghana Institute of Christian Studies and is located in Kumasi. It is a preacher's training school which we help to support as a congregation. We will actually be able to participate in the graduation ceremony while there. Another opportunity we will have is to speak to returning graduates. There are over 30 graduates now from this school and about 7 more ready to graduate (I will give you more detailed and accurate numbers upon my return.)

Finally, brother Benjamin wants me to go by and greet the Chief of Offinso. I have met him before and he actually came to one of our assemblies in the past. He lost his wife recently and I hope we are able to have a positive effect on him with the Gospel of Christ.

Please continue to keep our journey, safety and health in your daily prayers. This is always a rewarding, yet difficult trip full of continuous labors for the Lord. However, Brent and I feel blessed and privileged to go and be a part of this work of God.

I also want to once again say THANKS to all of you who helped brother Brent, as well as myself out with funds for this trip. We will be able to do a lot of good while there with helping out in specially needs. The fact is, you can never have enough money to do all the things needed or to meet all the needs we will face, but we commit to do our best with what we have been blessed with and to do what we can in the name of and to the glory of God Almighty.

I will miss being with you brethren again this Sunday, but I do appreciate so much those who have been willing to help in my absence. Lord Willing, I look forward to being back with you to worship God on September 30th. May God bless you all!
