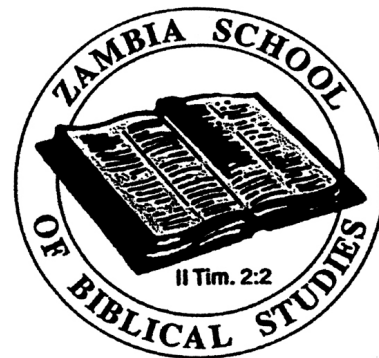

WHAT FATHERS CAN GIVE THEIR CHILDREN
Ephesians 6:4
" And you, fathers, do not provoke your children to wrath, but bring them up in the training and admonition of the Lord."

Someone has said, "Fathers don't have second chances." We have one time around with our children and we better do it right. Here are some things fathers need to give their children:
Give them a good mother. Every child deserves a good, Christian mother. David had some rascals for sons and one reason was that some of the women he married were not fit to be mothers. Fathers, if you want good children, marry a woman who will make them a good mother.
Give them a good father. One of the biggest sins of Americans is the failure of fathers to really be there for their children.. Children need a father. They need a good father. A good father loves his children. God, the perfect father, is our example. With Him as a perfect example we have no excuse for failing.
A good father provides for his children. Our Father provides for all of our needs. And He demands of us that we do the same: "If anyone does not provide for his own, and especially for those of his household, he has denied the faith and is worse than an unbeliever." (1 Timothy 5:8)

A good father disciplines his children. God disciplines us and we better discipline our children if we want them to turn out right. Excerpts from Bill Richardson via the Bona Beacon

Foolishness *is* bound up in the heart of a child;
The rod of correction will drive it far from him. (Proverbs 22:15)

If you endure chastening, God deals with you as with sons; for what son is there whom a father does not chasten? But if you are without chastening, of which all have become partakers, then you are illegitimate and not sons.

Furthermore, we have had human fathers who corrected *us*, and we paid *them* respect. Now no chastening seems to be joyful for the present, but painful; nevertheless, afterward it yields the peaceable fruit of righteousness to those who have been trained by it. (Hebrews 12: 7-9)
