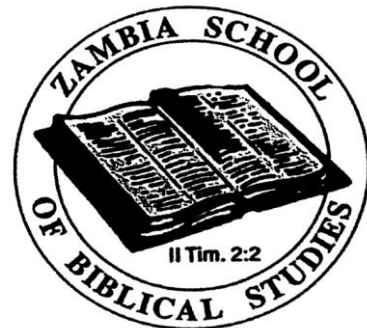

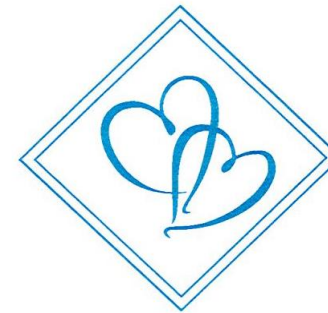

Our VBS will be August 3rd -7th. Please be planning to be present for all sessions.

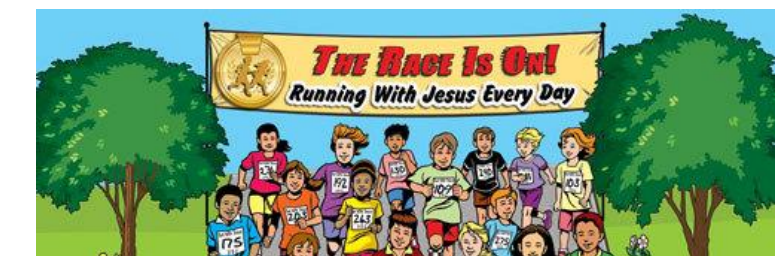
Trey and Ruth will be married July 26th. Pray that this young Christian couple will have a great wedding. We wish them well.
