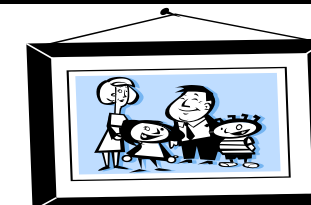
Remember our sick, shut-ins, and those of our number who are suffering from the many challenges of life. They need our prayers, visits and cards.
