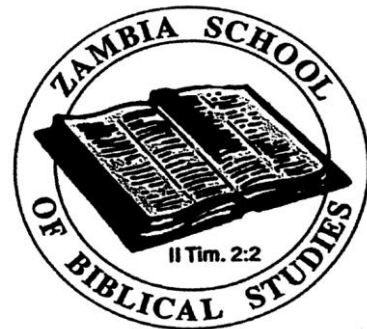

as they are doing a great job.

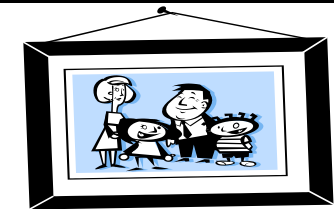
