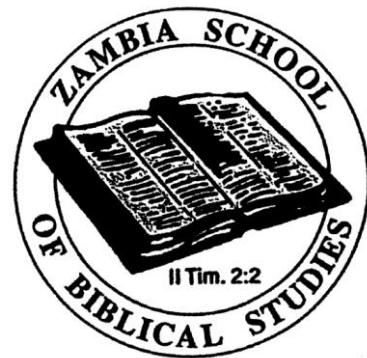

ELDER'S CORNER:

(This was an email from last week.)

Edith and I are safe in Uganda. The trip was difficult as always, traveling through Dallas/Fort Worth airport and after an hour and a half, boarded our over 9 hour flight to London. After a four hour layover in London we boarded our 9 hour flight to Kampala. All flights were on time and our luggage reached with us which is unusual for these flights. After entering the airport at Entebbe, Uganda we had to undergo an Ebola test and spent almost an hour getting our visas. By that time it was almost midnight. So around 3 in the morning we finally got to our African Hotel and got some rest. We stayed at the Hotel for two nights to recover from the trip. After that, we made the 6 hour trip to Busia. To our surprise the walls of the building were almost completed. Every day I have been at the building site. Things are going well and now that I am here, the more I know I made the right decision to come. The first week in June is our target date to have the first building completed and the school will move to that location at that time. Please pray for our safe return on April 9th. There have been terrorist threats here but we continue to trust in God for our safe return. See you soon, the Lord willing.
