ELDER'S CORNER:

Excerpt from an article, "You will Be Lost But Not Alone,"
by Jay Yeager

The freedom of choice does not cease
when one becomes a child of God. There is a
road full of pain and remorse that leads away
from God and the blessings in Christ (Ephesians
1:3), and it is as accessible as the road that leads
to Him (Luke 8:11-15). This appeal is directed
toward those who have or are near to walking
that path, a plea to consider the seriousness of
that course.

The very nature of this matter
necessitates being very candid, but please do not
equate candidness as being uncaring or harsh. I
assure you such is not the case. Despite the
common misconception, which suggests that love
is only connected with positive statements and
tolerating attitudes, the person who is genuinely
concerned for lost souls will never withhold the
truth necessary to save a soul from death
regardless of how much that truth may
temporarily discomfort the hearer (Hebrews
12:5-11). Ephesians 4:15 makes clear that the
truth must be preached, just as it makes clear
that it must be preached in love.
