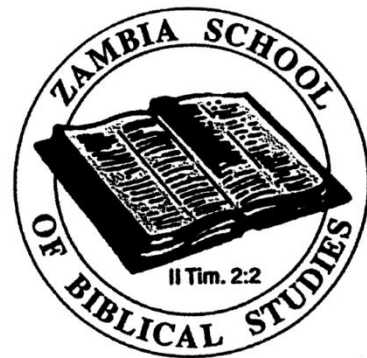

WHY ATTEND BIBLE CLASS?

When I was growing up, the vitamin craze had just started. We thought it was a big deal when Mom would buy us Bugs Bunny vitamins to take. Mom was very concerned about our health, and wanted us to get proper nutrition plus supplements. The labels on all vitamins set the standard of "Minimum Daily Requirements." This is what the body needs to get by. On the minimum, you will not see improvement, only maintenance.

Many in the church feel that they can get by without attending Bible Class. Reality does not confirm this. Those who attend Bible classes fare better in their marriages, do better as parents, and have a tendency to live up to their commitments. It is obvious that doing minimum spiritual ingestion does not lead to improvement in spiritual health. Actually minimums do not help much in maintenance. We need to improve our spiritual diets.

The bible teaches the need for a daily diet of scripture. Nobility demands it (Acts 17:11). Good work habits demand it (2 Timothy 2:15). Wisdom demands it (Colossians 1:9, 10). Self improvement demands it (2 Timothy 4:12-16). Our overall growth demands it (2 Peter 3:18). Bible class will improve your spiritual diet.
