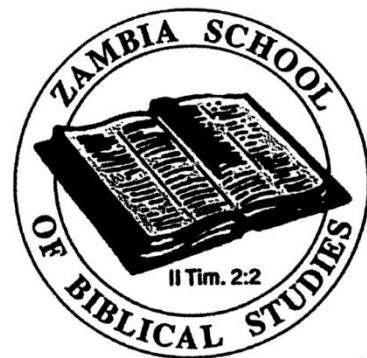

THE K.E. FAMILY LIFELINE

Hello everyone! I hope you all are doing well. Things are going fine in Africa. However, we sure miss you all and our families back in the U.S.A. So far we have had a great trip and have enjoyed being with the faculty, students at the school, as well as the brethren in this area. Brent and I have both taught several days in the school, as well as on Sunday.

On the Lord's Day we were each able to preach at different congregations in the area. Brent preached at the Highland Church of Christ, located here on the school property. I went with brother Webby to Kasangula, a town on the border of Zambia and Botswana, about 40 miles away from Livingstone. These brethren are really having a struggle there as they have just had a split in their congregation. They lost about half of the congregation, due to the fact that many wanted to begin having choirs in worship. Anyway, several of them are trying to remain faithful and the brothers at the school are trying to encourage them and to help them organize a place of their own to worship in. Please keep these good brethren in your prayers.

On Sunday evening, we were able to head out to the Martindale farm. This is where the school used to be located when we first moved to Zambia. This is also the farm where brother Lloyd and Pearl Henson lived! It was good to see the brethren there and to have the opportunity to preach to them again. There are many wonderful and precious memories out at that old farm. It was touching to share this time with my brethren there.

Well, we have only been in Africa for about 5 days and so far we have been without power 4 of those days, for 8 hours at a time. They have begun to ration power here in Zambia since April. The Government says it's because of the drought, but the people say that it's all politics, having to do with the elections coming up. Oh, the plight of Africa! We also woke up Saturday morning to no water. One of the pumps at the school quit working and will have to be replaced. On top of all of this we are in Zambia during the hottest time of the year, October. The temperature is well in the 90s and probably tops 100 often; and by the way, we have about zero moisture. So, Brent and I are trying to stay positive through all of these inconveniences! They sure remind us of just how blessed and spoiled we are as Americans.

Well, please continue to pray for us and our families while we are in Africa. I love you all, miss you and look forward to seeing you again in a couple of weeks. We have been trying to keep you up to date with our trip on Facebook, so feel free to check in with us there if you want more details and pictures. I will have a lot more to write about next week.

I continue to pray for you all and for the success of the gospel meeting. I know brother Keith is doing a great job and I wish I was there. May God bless us all as we strive to do His Will.
