



Well, we are in our final week in Zambia, and we are looking forward to coming home later this week. In fact, by the time you get this bulletin, we will either be about to leave or already on our way back home. Lord Willing, we will be leaving Livingstone, Zambia on Thursday Afternoon. We will fly from Livingstone to Johannesburg, South Africa and about 7:30 (African time), we board the flight back to the U.S. A. The flight from Johannesburg to Atlanta is the long 15 hour one. We will get to Atlanta around 6:00 a.m. Friday morning, and should catch the flight back to Springfield at around 9:30. We hope to be home by lunch on Friday.

We have enjoyed being in Zambia, teaching, and getting to know the students, as well as meeting many of the Christians in the area. It has also been nice for me to see some of my brethren which I have not seen in over 5 years. Yes our trip has been a blessed and busy one, but we are certainly ready to come home. We miss you all and Lord Willing I look forward to seeing you all this coming Sunday.

I know Brent and I are about worn out, mentally and physically. We have taught or preached every day (except Saturdays). On top of that all the power outages and water shutoffs have about mentally drained us. The temperature has been right at 100 ever since we have been here, so the heat zaps it out of your as well. We have certainly had our share of sweating, and I have never drunk so much water in my life. Anyway, I look forward to getting home so I can recover some.

I hear that things are going well at the Bible Institute of Missouri. I have really been thinking about the students the last few days, because I know that this week is finals week and I know two of the finals they have to take are mine. I am so proud of our students at the BIM. They are all doing such a great job. I look forward to teaching our new class this coming Quarter. It is always exciting to teach a new class. I will also be teaching the second year students Greek II. Anyway, classes start back next Monday, so I will be teaching next Tuesday. I look forward to another good quarter.

Please continue pray for Brent and I as we return home this week. I look forward to seeing you all very soon. I hope you have a great week! May God bless us all as we strive to do His Will and obey all His Precepts. I love you all!
