

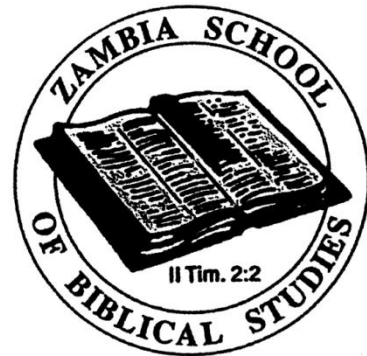

During this time, we will be able to cover special courses needed and to encourage the faculty, students, as well as on weekends, the churches in the area.

On October 6, Brent and I are going to be the first teachers to go for two weeks of teaching. Our tickets will be \$1775 each and we will need a little extra for travel expenses and food, while in Zambia. However, the costs while in Zambia are usually more minimal, because we already have a little apartment we can stay in that is located in the school building.

If any of you are able to help with this trip, I am needing to try and raise the money for my ticket. If you consider helping, please do not take any money out of your regular weekly contribution, but if you are able to help above that it certainly would be appreciated. I do believe that this effort will be a great encouragement to the good brethren at the Zambia School of Biblical Studies as well as the brethren there. Please remember Brent and me in your prayers as we prepare for this trip and as we will be leaving in just a few weeks.

Well, I hope to see you at our Mid-Week gathering this evening. It will also be a wondrous blessing to assemble this Sunday to again worship our wondrous creator. Remember, those who serve God always receive the benefits thereof. Are you giving God your best? God Bless!
