

So please prepare for this 5<sup>th</sup> Sunday and give extra if possible, knowing that everything over our regular contribution will go toward the new school in Ghana. Please do not take away from your regular contribution to give extra for this need! If you have any questions please let me know. Thanks for your help with this matter.

I hope you all are present for our last night of the meeting tonight. Remember that the Lord's day will be here before we know it, so let's all prepare and be ready to gather and worship our God. Also, consider that fact that the faithful are blessed by God and rewarded for their labors. Are you giving God your best? God bless!
